Alex and Joe competed in L3 'In Age', Sam and Caiden in L1 'In Age' and Chris, Jared and Woody competing in the U8 Age category (L1). The boys had outstanding results with Alex winning L3 overall and Joe placing 6th overall coming 3rd on pommel and high bar. In L1 Sam came = 29th and Caiden 43rd.
