

Alex Taylor took the gold at L4 and qualified to the National at Birmingham for the 4<sup>th</sup> year running. Jared Field was the first ever MAG gymnasts for L&DGC to enter the L1 Elite Grades and finished 6<sup>th</sup> qualifying for the Nationals finals for the first time.



At the London Open in Redbridge Alex Taylor won gold on High Bar and finished 4<sup>th</sup> overall. Matthew and Owen did very well at Guest level with Owen taking two Gold medals for Parallel Bars and Pommel Horse.

At the National grade finals in Birmingham Alex Taylor did well finishing 13<sup>th</sup> overall at Level 4.
