Welcome to the 2<sup>nd</sup> edition of our 2016 newsletter.

As we celebrate our 40th year 2016 is already proving remarkable in both participation and success on many fronts. With Sophie having won her first British Title and being selected into the GB British Squad she was selected for two important overseas team internationals winning gold in Switzerland. This was followed by five of our team gym gymnasts being selected for the GB European Championships Squad which takes place next October in Slovenia. This a great complement to our coaches.

Having introduced a special disabilities class two of our gymnasts took part in their first competition both winning gold. The participation in competitions is not limited to our elite gymnasts. More than 100 recreational gymnasts competed in Surrey Floor and Vault winning 38 medals-well done Jane, Dianne, Kevin and

Our coaches continue to enhance their qualification levels. Charlotte & Kim have now passed their L4 Team Gym and Ryan progresses his Men's artistic knowledge while Jane, Dawn and Kevin are also attending General Gymnastics Modules at Level 3.

Having introduced a trainee programme, we are delighted to see so many young coaches having gone through our training programme and qualified. In recent weeks Leeva, Leah and Sophie have qualified and are now coaching classes. Mariaan is also a new coach to our team working with Natalie as well as providing her skills to the general programme.

Trainees are invited into the programme by Jane and Kevin and are trailed before being accepted. The club meets 50% of the course fees. We also seek financial support from Surrey Playing Fields and BG South East both providing bursary funding but we cannot guarantee support as funds are limited.

At the other end of the coaching spectrum we are delighted to welcome Andrey as Head Coach Men's Artistic. He brings a wealth of experience from his coaching and gymnastics years in Russia. He has coached in this country for 10 years and now oversees the men's squads as well as casting an eye over the general gymnasts classes looking for potential young gymnasts to trial.

Next month 12 gymnasts will go to the Italy as their reward for winning the 2015 International Team Gym competition. The pursuit of excellence in team gym will be followed in August by one of the world leading coaches coming to the club for a training camp. Finally we are looking for parent who would be interested in working with Tina and Nadia in the club's social activities which this year of course linked to the 40th anniversary. 2002-2005 Deputy Director of a Department of Gymnastics Sports School for Children and Youth, School no. 1 USSR From 2005 came to the UK to provide high level gymnastics coaching boys and girls in the Surbiton area; selected by him gymnasts have again been members of regional teams and competed for the London region.
